We have met many people here (nothing like an erupting volcano and airport closure to get people to engage with each other) who are desperate to get home for many different reasons; they have no money, no medication, children back in Australia, work commitments, and so on. It's times like this you fully appreciate living in Australia and knowing our systems and infrastructures are world class.

I have been thinking a lot about the Serenity Prayer. This prayer was up in our kitchen when I was growing up.

And wisdom to know the difference.*

I welcome back all teachers, students and parents to Term 3. A very special welcome to our new families. I know all teachers have been preparing for Term 3 during the break and are ready for a busy term ahead. We have many events on this term and I invite you to attend as many as you can.

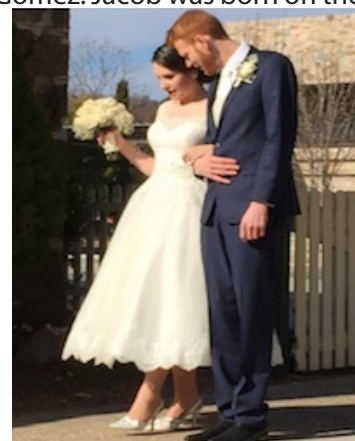
## Focus Value for July - "Show Tolerance"
