Curriculum Outline

Religion

Year 1 will look at 'Church as Community', focusing on how we pray and participate in Church celebrations. We will also look at all the different ways we can show our love for God.

English

We will continue to identify the features of all text types this term. Our main focus will be on Poetry. We will continue to use *Sound Waves* to improve our phonemic spelling skills.

Mathematics

Our focus for the first 3 weeks of term will be *Probability* and *Multiplication & Division*. We will continue our 'hands on' approach to learning Mathematical skills and developing our understanding of Mathematical language.

History

This term we will be learning all about family and how family life has changed or remained the same over time. We will look specifically at the roles and structure of the family and how it is different from past generations.

STEM (Science, Tech, Engineering, Math)

Our exciting unit this term looks at changes in the sky and landscape. We will be posing questions, investigating, making predictions and collecting data based on the observable changes around us. A great topic to explore given the change in weather this term!

Creative Arts

Visual Arts: Our topic this term "Faith in Art" explores how many artists were inspired by God and Jesus to create different artworks. Children will be given the opportunity to create their own pieces of work, using different techniques.

Dance: Children will be given the opportunity to perform expressively with awareness of others, taking into consideration the timing and mood of the music.

Health: Year 1 will investigate how every person is unique and has God-given gifts that make us special.
