## TERM 4 OVERVIEW

### Curriculum Outline

#### Religious Education

**Prayer helps, prayer heals:** This term students will learn about how prayer enables us to reconcile our relationships with God and with others. Links to Sacrament of Reconciliation.

#### English

During English, students will build on their independent reading skills through selecting and reading 'Just Right' texts. They will be building on their stamina and comprehension skills. Students will explore fiction and non-fiction texts by which they will develop their skills in retelling, clarifying, summarising and asking questions about different texts. Children will continue to focus on text structures, punctuation, grammar and spelling during writing.

#### Maths

Throughout this term, students will be developing skills in: position and mapping, patterns and algebra, time, mass and area and length.

#### Creative Arts

This term we will be focusing on various artistic techniques including Dance. Towards the end of the term we will also be creating Christmas craft using a variety of mediums.

#### Health

We will continue learning about what healthy and balanced lifestyles look like.

#### History

We will be continuing to look at community celebrations around the world.

#### Science:

Students will continue investigating how shadows change throughout the day and link these changes to the movement of the Sun.
