This Thursday and Friday, Year 4 students will be taken on a mini tour of Queanbeyan, lead by Nichole Overall, to investigate how humans have shaped the environment to suit their wants and needs. Students will be using digital cameras to take 360 degree photos to create an immersive VR experience as part of their STEM unit this term. The excursion will take place from 9:30am-11:30am and will be lead along a route looking at the following:

- Former place of Cantle's Cottage
- Benedict House
- Christ Church
- Queen Elizabeth Park

We will finish the excursion by having lunch at Queen Elizabeth Park, so students will need to have a packed meal for first break on the day their class is going on the excursion, as lunch orders from the canteen will be unavailable to them. Class days for the excursion are:
